- **Summer Bridge:** Before you start at Seattle Central College you will learn about life on campus, meet instructors and staff, and learn about college resources and support.

Seattle Promise scholarship guidelines

▶ What is the program?

The Seattle Promise program is designed to provide the financial support and personal guidance you need to succeed in college. The program is open to all students of eligible Seattle public high schools regardless of GPA, income, or background.

Seattle Promise scholars are eligible for the following:

- Support applying for financial aid and college applications
- Full coverage of any tuition expenses remaining after other scholarships and financial aid
- Assistance with choosing and registering for classes
- Preparation for the transition to college
- Guidance and mentorship while attending college

▶ What are the application requirements?
